Just a gentle nudge to advise you to get your grant application in quickly. The timeline for this runs out on 18th September. You must apply online this year, either by printing off, scanning, filling in and emailing back to us the application form on our website's news section (main page) or by filling in the online form which can be found under the tab 'Aldwick Parish Council' then 'Publications' on our site.

We are also running a Covid fund to endable grants to be made to organisations which are helping indivudals in our community. There is no deadline for this, but you should apply using the grant form. Importantly, **please mark your application Covid -19 grant.**

Pavement licences



If you're a restaurant or café owner, you can now apply for a pavement licence to use highway space adjacent to your premises. Arun District Council is fast tracking these applications which are currently free of charge.
