

# Covid App – Please download!

**The Track and Trace app** is now available to download from Google Play or Apple Play stores. The app includes a notification feature which will alert you if you've been near another app user who tests positive for coronavirus; if your local area (postcode district) has



a changed risk status; or if you have visited a venue which later reports an outbreak while you were there. If you test positive, the app will ask you to allow those you've been in contact with to be alerted. The people notified will not know who you are. So please, if you have a smart phone, help protect yourself and others so that we can get control of the virus.
