



Help with transport to vaccine appointments – Mid Sussex, Horsham, Crawley, Adur & Worthing residents

Community Transport Sussex has been given funding for up to 1500 free of charge journeys for residents who need assistance getting to their vaccine appointments. The minibuses are thoroughly cleaned between passengers, drivers will be wearing appropriate PPE, and procedures will be in place to ensure the journeys are as safe as possible for passengers. Transport is available to and from your home address. Availability of journeys is mostly between 10am and 2pm, due to driver schedules, however, if your appointment is outside of these times, you can still get in touch to discuss options. Chichester area They are not included in the free trip offer via Community Transport Sussex, but Manhood Mobility may be able to help – 01243 671881. Usually they are for residents of the West Manhood area but during the pandemic they have been helping residents who live within Chichester if they can. There's a bit of a gap in Chichester for community transport but wheelchair accessible taxis like Starline and Alfa Taxis are available (both WSCC approved suppliers).

Others to try are Arun Community Transport (Bognor & Littlehampton area) and Tandem (Midhurst & surrounds).
