Members supported the item in principle and agreed that the Clerk, Cllr Bass and Cllr Smith approach the Landowner/Leaseholder to make enquiries regarding the acquirement of said public amenities. Members also agreed that the project should be delegated to the Amenities Committee during the investigations and returned to Council for any decisions.
