One of its Members, Cllr Gillian Edom says: ‘We want to include the enhancement of other aspects of the Aldwick natural environment and to work to improve its biodiversity.

The kind of thing the group will be doing is helping residents to encourage native wildlife by connecting existing habitats, increasing the number of wildflower verges, encouraging residents to create wildlife-friendly gardens and of course, planting more trees.’

The group is calling for organisations within the parish who are already caring for our green spaces, as well as school children and members of the public who have a particular interest in the natural environment to meet with them on Monday 7th March at 7 pm at the Parish Council Offices.
