Planters and grounds maintenance



The council provides flower planters at Rose Green – we hope you'll agree they looked good this year, after we put additional plans in place to cope with very dry spells - despite it not seeming the greatest summer weather there were some extremely sunny stretches without rain and the plants weren't going to survive without a watering regime. We also look after the Millennium Gardens and our allotments at Rose Green. We're currently

reviewing future options for grounds maintenance and planting to look at the best way of keeping things ship-shape for residents and visitors to enjoy, and hope to bring more news in due course.

Tree planting

On the subject of planting, the Council continued its annual participation in the County Council's Donate A



Tree scheme. Aldwick is a lovely, leafy area with generally lots of trees but the flip side is that a large number get removed for various reasons – disease, old age, maybe causing damage, safety reasons. It's well known that trees are great for the environment in so many ways, eg wildlife habitat, absorbing CO2, shade, slows soil erosion, good for mental health; and we want to ensure Aldwick stays attractively green with plenty of young trees, so once again donated to support the planting of 11 new saplings in Aldwick.
