The Annual Parish Meeting takes place at the Parish Rooms, off Pryors Lane (behind the library) on **Tuesday 6th May at 6.30pm** – this is a meeting hosted by us but for YOU, <u>not</u> a council meeting, and a chance for you to meet your councillors, ask any questions. There'll be a short presentation from Arun Community Transport about the organisation, plus a talk from the County Council about the new grass cutting regime they're trialling in Aldwick. There'll be brief reports from the Council on our past year. We look forward to welcoming you and dealing with any questions about parish and community affairs. It's useful, but not essential, to have written questions in advance if possible, the better to answer them.

new financial year budget available that's now had replacement seat slats and was very quickly being used again.
