



Nyetimber Lane/Pryors Lane road closures

The essential gas main works through June onwards, and recent footway resurfacing, have caused some disruption in reaching shops and services. It's a rolling road closure system and SGN advise that they aim to free up sections for full accessibility as they move along. They anticipate being finished by mid-end July, we are told. All the shops and businesses in those areas can be reached, and the GP surgery, library, community centre and parish council are also fully accessible, via diversions. We are assured that access to the Avisford Park car park will be maintained. Contact the office if you'd like guidance on diversions and bus routes.

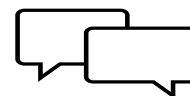
Dementia Advice Bus
