



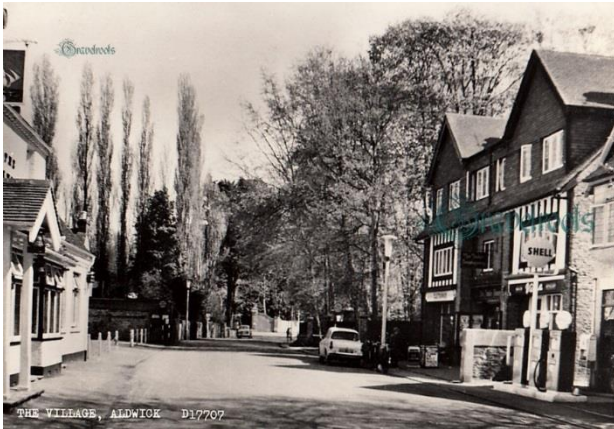
Aldwick Parish Council Monthly Newsletter July/August 2018

West Sussex Walking and Cycling Strategy to 2026

West Sussex have launched a Walking and Cycling Strategy for the county which will run until 2026. They want to ensure that cycling and walking are recognised as important travel modes and that they are considered part of the transport mix. They'd like us to make cycling and walking a preferred option for shorter journeys and even as part of longer journeys. Importantly, they also want to reduce the number of cyclists and pedestrians killed or injured annually on our roads.
